Comments: Historical Information Sign missing as of Saturday 19 September 2015; sign is located just before the Heathcote Brook Bridge on OLD Route 27; sign was mounted on the same pole as the weight limit sign (which remains.) Mile marker on opposite side of Heathcote Brook Bridge is 1216-150/3.07 [located in South Brunswick Twp] I can furnish before (April 2014) and after (19 September 2015) photos. Text of missing sign: "MILLSTONE RIVER The original wooden bridge at this location was destroyed by Washington's troops on January 3, 1777 following the Battle of Princeton to prevent pursuit by Lord Cornwallis" The sign actually is located just before Heathcote Brook, NOT the Millstone River
